

NATIONAL SERIES 2010

National Championship Round dates:

6-7th February 2010 Lake Karapiro, Cambridge, Waikato
27-28th February 2010 Lake Rotoiti, Nelson Lakes National Park

Entrants:

- 2) Series Committee: Andrea Robinson, Denise Moughan & Ben Ryan.
- 3) Entry: A deposit of \$100.00 per boat by 30th August. An optional six more payments of \$50 in six months to pay off entry fee. Total \$400.00 is due and can be paid in full (preferred) if possible. All entry payments to me made to NZPBA and sent to National Secretary with fully completed entry forms. All figures include G.S.T.
- 4) Classes: Registered classes may be combined to make better racing for both the competitor and public. You may still claim your own class title if your class is combined, provided there are sufficient numbers – this at discretion of series committee.
 - 1 Classes will be as per current NZPBA Rulebook. The committee reserve the right to combine like classes where applicable by either description or speed grouping.
 - 2 Each class to have three heats per round for their National title
 - 3 There will be one heat per round for the King of the Nationals
- 4) One person per class to liaise with Series Committee, this person to be named and be in attendance at drivers briefing on the day of competition.
- 5) Entrants to attend both rounds of Nationals. Withdrawal / non-attendance at either round shall be in writing to series committee and will be judged at discretion of the committee. Each circumstance will be assessed on an individual basis and will be refunded accordingly at the discretion of the Series Committee and it would be only in exceptional circumstances that this would be done.
- 6) Entries to National Series after close off date will be at discretion of Series Committee.
- 7) No class may run a series of their own without prior Series Committee approval. Drivers groups / classes please write to committee to explain position and request approval before season starts.

Hosting Clubs

- 8) Full Race Program with the event times including scrutineering, briefing, race program and entertainment by 1st November.
- 9) Host Club must supply Series Committee the intended local promotion e.g. TV, radio, paper and a budget for the event by 1st November.
- 9) Program must be no longer than 15 minutes between event, barring accidents etc
- 10) Host club to advise Series Committee, commentators and officials by 1st November 2009
- 11) Series Committee to approve Race Controller and Race Starter for both events.

- 12) Prize giving to be carried out no later than 1 hr after conclusion of final race.
- 13) Host Club to organize social functions.
- 14) Denise Moughan / Promotions Officer to work with Host clubs re funding, sponsorship, council applications to help get costings for TV, shipping and to help with the co-ordination of the total event.
- 15) If you do not enter the 2010 National Series but wish to attend one round of the Nationals you can compete by paying the host club entry fee for the event. You may not be able to run with your class, (this will be at discretion of series committee depending on numbers and fields) otherwise we will provide you with three races per day in a combined class of entries received for that round.
- 16) Points system: We will use the International Points series for the national series below.
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| 1-400 points | 5-127 points | 9-40 points |
| 2-300 points | 6- 95 points | 10-30 points |
| 3-225 points | 7- 71 points | 11-22 points |
| 4-169 points | 8- 53 points | 12-17 points |
- 17) If you have not already entered please do so no later than 30th August so we can get the program / classes sorted out for the coming season.
